

Thai Language, Culture and Professional Ethics

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The teaching profession has been recognized as a regulated profession according to the Teacher and Educational Personnel Council Act since B.E. 2546 (2003). Additionally, Item 5, Paragraph 2 of the Teachers Council Regulations on Teacher Licenses, B.E. 2547 (2004), states that it is the obligation of all foreigner nationals who wish to teach in Thai schools to be trained and evaluated under the criteria and processes stipulated by the Teachers' Council of Thailand. Consequently, this training program has been created in accordance with the above regulations in order to provide foreign teachers with proper knowledge and understanding required for obtaining the Teacher's License within the Kingdom of Thailand.

Objectives

- To provide foreign teachers with insight into the various aspects of Thai society, including lifestyle, culture and identity in conjunction with a professional code of ethics for teachers, so that they can perform their teaching responsibilities more effectively.

- To instill the attendees with both knowledge and skills so that they can meet the criteria for the Teacher's License

- At least 20 years old

- Foreigners with a degree in Education or its equivalency or any program acknowledged by the Teacher Council of Thailand Board
